Dr. Davidson is a double board certified Obstetrician and Gynecologist with subspecialized training as a high risk obstetrician in Maternal Fetal Medicine/Perinatology. She provides consultation and comprehensive care for complicated or high-risk pregnancies and pre-conception counseling to women planning for pregnancy. As a perinatal consultant and women's health expert, she cares for pregnant women with challenging obstetric and fetal diagnoses, provides first and second trimester ultrasound screening, performs diagnostic procedures and collaborates with OB/GYNs to monitor the progress of a woman's pregnancy.

She is an alumnus of the University of Miami where she earned her Bachelor of Science in Biochemistry and Molecular Biology. After completing her undergraduate degree, she ventured to the northeast to pursue her medical education and training. She earned her medical degree from Georgetown University School of Medicine in Washington, DC and completed her residency training in Obstetrics & Gynecology at Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland. During those years, she treated women with a wide variety of complex obstetric conditions and soon realized that her passion is to provide for women with high-risk obstetric needs and serve a greater role in improving pregnancy care and outcomes. She therefore pursued her subspecialty training and completed a Maternal Fetal Medicine Fellowship at Albert Einstein College of Medicine - Montefiore Medical Center in New York.

She is passionate about serving her community and educating women about healthy lifestyle choices before, during pregnancy and beyond.
