Bob Denholtz is president, CEO and director of DureX Inc., a New Jersey-based contract manufacturer of metal stampings, sheet metal fabrications, assemblies and finished products for Fortune 500 companies. Established in 1946, DureX employs a staff of over 150. The company has steadily increased revenues by growing its customer base through contract manufacturing and acquisitions. DureX wholly owns four subsidiaries: Creative Serving, a food service equipment company; Sternvent, a dust collection product line; Dur-A-Guard, a product line that specializes in guarding trucks for pedestrian and cyclist

safety; and White Rail, a garment handling conveyor system.

Denholtz currently serves on the University of Miami Presidents Council and the School of Communication Dean’s Advisory Committee. He continues to assist University Admissions with recruiting academic prospects by meeting with potential UM students at college fairs in his area. He has also served on the Alumni Board and the Athletics Visiting Committee.
